ELIGIBLE PERSONS

Every athlete - national and international. Austrian championship titles are only awarded to Austrian athletes.

ENTRY FEE FOR COMPETITORS

€ 35, - for a competition (includes the Wake the Lake Basic Ticket)

€ 15, - for every further competition.

FAIR PADDLING

Fair paddling is expected from all participants. Rough unsportsmanlike behavior can be punished by the race director with disqualification.

SUP paddling by kneeling, sitting or lying down is subject to disqualification. After a fall, however, 5 paddle strikes may be carried out while kneeling to paddle. Exceptions in dangerous situations will be announced by the organizer.

DRAFTING

Drafting between participants of all rating classes is allowed.

SAFETY

In critical weather conditions, the Race Director can order the wearing of cold protection clothing. Wearing a Safty Leash is mandatory. Violation can lead to disqualification.

DOPING BAN

The NADA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time, form part of these competition rules. Doping controls can in principle be carried out at every competition.

JURY

The jury consists of Racedirector, the event organization (or representative) and two participants (can be determined by the race director and event organization). If a participant is directly involved in a protest as a jury member, he / she has to abstain. The jury negotiates protests of the participants and can disqualify in case of unsportsmanlike behavior of participants or in case of violations of the material or other rules (after previous written protest). In addition, after notification to the Notice Board, it may carry out checks on the material of individual participants (before or after the competitions). Participants who withdraw their board from material control can be disqualified.

PROTESTS

Protests of any kind must always be submitted in writing to the Racedirector within 30 minutes after the end of the competition. Protest fee is 50 euros, which will be refunded in case of a positive decision for the protesters.

The boards can be unloaded at the park entrance. Then drive to one of the Krumpendorf parking lots. Event ticket and starter card are available at the Wake The Lake ticket desk (Parkbad entrance). This will allow the board to be carried the quickest way through the park entrance to the lake.
